

SPIRIT DRESS UP DAY GUIDELINES

- NO leggings, or tights will be permitted
- NO holes in jeans
- Shorts must be fingertip in length for boys & girls
- Dresses/tutus must be fingertip in length and shorts worn underneath
- Must wear closed toe shoes (no crocks or slippers)
- Jeans, wind pants or sweatpants must fit appropriately and follow dress up theme
- No exposed midriffs, low necklines, tank tops, or spaghetti straps.
- No face coverings
- Hats are allowed if they follow the dress up theme. Must be taken off inside the classroom
- Overall, when choosing an outfit each day, the dress code policies of modesty and appropriate fit must be of primary concern.
- Face paint or temporary hair color are only allowed if pertaining to the theme.
- If you choose not to participate, you must wear a regular school uniform.
- Students who are not following Spirit Week guidelines may be asked to call home and arrange for a change of clothes.
- Students will be written a thunderstorm for breaking spirit dress guidelines and will not be allowed to participate in dress up days going forward.
- The administration is the final judge as to whether you are actually dressed in the theme. If you have doubts, choose a different outfit that is more clearly in theme.
